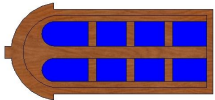
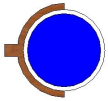
1880 Town is located between Kadoka and Murdo on Interstate 80, in south western South Dakota.



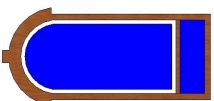
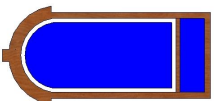
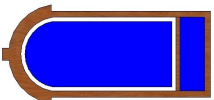
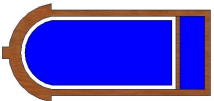
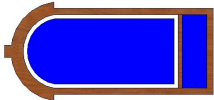
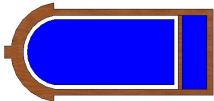




The model bas may be glud to 1mm card or to foamboard.



These window pices may be cut out and glud to the model to make a 3-D look.



optional lamp post.
Make a two four sided tubes and slide the longer thinner post into the short outer base. The fold and glue the yellow "glass" pieces into the lamp and glue it to the top of the post.
